## MONDAY 8/24

- Breakfast at Port of Fort Wayne (7:00am-8:00am)
- Depart at 8:00am, restroom stop en route
- Tour the Leo Berbee Bulb Company in Marysville, OH  
Learn how this second generation, family-owned, Dutch company laid down roots in Marysville and is a major distributor of bulbs and perennials to notable clients across America such as: the Pentagon, National Park Service and the Columbus Zoo. (Approx 75 minutes, some standing, minimal walking)
- **Lunch on own, Marysville, OH \***  
Enjoy lunch at your choice of location in this quaint, walkable uptown area. Most restaurants are within 3-4 blocks.
- Private showing of "Song Sung Blue" movie at the Avalon Theater in uptown Marysville. "Song Sung Blue" is a 2025 biographical musical drama that tells the real life story of Mike and Claire Sardina. The couple was a "down-on-their-luck" Milwaukee couple who overcame many difficulties, including addition and a tragic accident to form the popular Neil Diamond tribute band named "Lightning & Thunder." The Avalon Theater is a 1930's art-deco venue that has been restored to a modern theater with vintage feel. Kick back with popcorn and pop and enjoy this entertaining movie. (2 hours 15 minutes)
- Check-in and relax at the hotel. (Approx. 1 hour)
- Depart for a driving tour of the Covered Bridges of Union County followed by dinner on a covered bridge. Sit back, relax, and let a seasoned guide navigate the pastoral countryside on a tour of the seven covered bridges of Union County. Four of the bridges are historic (constructed in the 1800s) and were built by local resident Reuben Partridge, a prolific builder who built well over 100 bridges in Ohio. This scenic driving tour includes expansive views of the Big Darby Plains Scenic Byway. (45 minute tour, followed by dinner. Minimal walking)

## TUESDAY 8/25

- Breakfast at hotel
- Driving tour of Dublin, OH  
A local guide will give us the history of Dublin, OH., and highlight local draws, noteworthy events, and 2 photo stops at local Art in Town locations. (75 minutes, minimal walking)
- **Lunch on own, Dublin, OH \***  
Dublin, OH is gorgeous! It is upscale, with gorgeous stone and brick buildings giving a European feel. Plenty of benches along the sidewalks to sit and relax in the shade if you choose a quick bite and people watching. The downtown is approx. 4 blocks by 2 blocks.
- Irish Dance 101  
This class, led by professional dancers, is heavy on the demonstration and enjoyment and concludes with optional participation to learn a few new moves. (1 hour)
- Learn about Buckeye Brass and Winds  
Owner Rob Phillips shares how his talented team breathes new life into old instruments. Known for being a top source for instrument repairs for The Ohio State University Marching Band, these highly skilled musicians will treat you to a brief musical performance of Civil War trumpets and the church's original organ after the tour. Located in what was once a church, the former sanctuary with beautiful stained-glass windows is the perfect setting for such an experience. (1 hour)
